

Parson's Farewell (Galley-Hey).

Tradition: Fieldtown

Origin: DL

6 dancers in 2 lines of 3. Face up.

Music: Parson's Farewell

Formula:

Once to yourself (8 bars)

Foot up and down

-----Chorus

Half gyp

-----Chorus

Back to back

-----Chorus

Rounds

-----Chorus

Finish:

Finish facing up with galley- caper-caper at end of final half-hey. Top 4 galley on the spot with negligible turning to face up. Bottom pair galley out of set approx 180 degrees to face up. All finish with two capers facing up.

Hold show briefly. Odds walk off towards top of set, evens turn out and follow.

Chorus:

Half hey with galleys. 'Fudge step' of 1-2-3-hop-1-2-3-4 rather than 1-2-3-hop-1-2-3-hop is needed by everyone to be on correct foot to galley out of set at end of hey.

Note:

This is unique amongst our Fieldtown hanky dances in having galleys in the hey rather than backing into place.
